AUGUST 2, 2020 Translation of the Relics of the Protomartyr and Archdeacon Stephen

GREAT VESPERS

LORD I CALL: Six stikhera of the Resurrection in tone 7, followed by four for the saint

Resurrection, tone 7: <u>Come</u>, let us rejoice in the Lord, Who de<u>stroyed</u> the do<u>min</u>ion of death! Let us <u>sing</u> to Him with the <u>bod</u>iless hosts, for He en<u>light</u>ened the race of <u>man</u>!// O our Maker and <u>Sav</u>ior, <u>glo</u>ry to You!

You en<u>dured</u> the Cross and <u>bur</u>ial for our sake. By Your <u>death</u>, You destroyed <u>death</u> as God. We fall <u>down</u> before Your Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day,// O <u>Savior</u>, <u>glory</u> to You!

When the A<u>pos</u>tles beheld the Resurrection of the <u>Mak</u>er, they were a<u>mazed</u> and sang the angelic praise. <u>This</u> is the <u>glory</u> of the Church. <u>This</u> is the richness of the <u>Kingdom.//</u> O Lord, crucified for our <u>sake</u>, <u>glory</u> to You!

You were <u>held</u> by lawless <u>men</u>, O Christ, but to <u>me</u>, You are God, and I am <u>not</u> ashamed. You were <u>smitten</u> on the cheek, but I do not de<u>ny</u> You. You were <u>nailed</u> to the Cross and I do not con<u>ceal</u> it, for I <u>glory</u> in Your Resurrection: Your <u>death</u> is my life.// O Almighty Lord and Lover of man, <u>glory</u> to You!

Ful<u>filling</u> the prophecy of <u>Da</u>vid, <u>Christ</u> manifested His greatness in Zion to the dis<u>ciples</u>. He is <u>praised</u> and always <u>glo</u>rified, to<u>get</u>her with the Father and the Holy <u>Spir</u>it. At <u>first</u> as the Word, He was <u>bod</u>iless, but <u>then</u> He took flesh and was <u>slain</u> for our sake.// He rose in power as the <u>Lov</u>er of man!

You de<u>scend</u>ed into hell as You <u>willed</u>, O Christ, over<u>throwing</u> death as God, and rising on the third day as <u>Master!</u> With Your<u>self</u> You raised Adam from the bonds of hell and from cor<u>ruption!//</u> Glory to Your Resurrection, only <u>Lov</u>er of man!

Saint Stephen, tone 8:

O <u>Stephen</u>, chosen by the <u>Apostles</u>, you were the first among the martyrs to <u>suffer</u>; you are the foundation of those who <u>serve</u> as <u>dea</u>cons. you enlighten with un<u>fad</u>ing light those who celebrate your radiant feast with <u>splen</u>dor, giving grace and <u>mer</u>cy to your <u>ser</u>vants. By your prayers, O martyr, guide them to ever<u>last</u>ing life!

O Stephen, martyr of Christ,

you received a crown of grace on your head, in ac<u>cord</u>ance with your name. You adorned your neck with a chain of <u>vir</u>tues as with <u>one</u> of gold. You became an all-wise dwelling of the Wisdom you <u>cher</u>ished, keeping it as your be<u>lov</u>ed.// Therefore you have been honored with grace and <u>glo</u>ry.

O most <u>hon</u>ored <u>Stephen</u>, first of the martyrs to <u>suffer</u>, you are crowned with grace and <u>glory</u>, O A<u>pos</u>tle. When you were stoned, you offered a crown to our <u>King</u> and God, spiritual and more valued than gold and <u>pre</u>cious stones.// Your deeds and <u>name</u> are <u>beau</u>tiful.// Remember <u>all</u> of us!

tone 2:

O most holy <u>Stephen</u>, you appeared as first among deacons and first among <u>mar</u>tyrs, for your <u>path</u> was to <u>holy</u> things, and you led many <u>mar</u>tyrs to the Lord. Thus, heaven was opened, and God ap<u>peared</u> to you.// Entreat Him that our <u>souls</u> may be saved!

GLORY... for the saint, tone 6:

O Apostle <u>Stephen</u>, you were shown to be first among martyrs and <u>dea</u>cons; the adornment of athletes, the strength of the faithful, and the glory of the <u>right</u>eous. As you stand before the throne of Christ, the <u>King</u> of all, ask that those who celebrate your honored <u>mem</u>ory may be counted worthy to be <u>cleansed</u> of their sins// and to inherit the Kingdom of <u>hea</u>ven!

NOW AND EVER...the Dogmatikon in tone 7: No tongue can speak of your wonderful childbearing, for the order of nature was over<u>ruled</u> by God. You were revealed to be a Mother above <u>nature</u>, for you re<u>mained</u> a Virgin beyond reason and under<u>stand</u>ing. Your conception was most glorious, O Theo<u>to</u>kos! The <u>man</u>ner of your giving birth was ineffable, O <u>Virgin</u>! <u>Knowing you to be the Mother of God, devoutly we pray to you://</u> "Be<u>seech</u> Him to <u>save</u> our souls!"

<u>APOSTIKHA:</u> All stikhera of the Resurrection in tone 7:

As the <u>Sav</u>ior of the world You a<u>rose</u> from the tomb. As <u>God</u> You resurrected the race of <u>man</u> with Your flesh.// O <u>Lord</u>, <u>glo</u>ry to You!

<u>Come</u>, let us worship the One Who <u>rose</u> from the dead, and en<u>light</u>ened all cre<u>a</u>tion!

By His <u>death</u>, He saved us from the <u>tor</u>ments of hell.// By His Resurrection He has granted us eternal <u>life</u> and great <u>mer</u>cy.

You de<u>scend</u>ed into hell, capturing <u>death</u>, O Christ. In three <u>days</u> You a<u>rose</u> again, resur<u>rec</u>ting us who glorify Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion,// O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of man.

When <u>You</u> were placed in the tomb as <u>one</u> asleep, the <u>sight</u> was great and <u>awe</u>some. But when <u>You</u> rose on the third day as al<u>mighty</u> God, <u>You</u> resurrected <u>Ad</u>am with Yourself.// Glory to Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion, only <u>Lov</u>er of man!

GLORY...for the saint, tone 8

Rejoice in the Lord, crown-bearer <u>Stephen!</u> You followed your <u>Mas</u>ter, for you were the first <u>mar</u>tyr of <u>Christ</u> our King. You abolished the deception of the <u>En</u>emy,// and you pray to the Lord on <u>our</u> behalf.

NOW AND EVER...Resurrection Theotokion in tone 8:

Unwedded Virgin, you ineffably conceived <u>God</u> in the flesh. O <u>Mother of God</u> most high, accept the cries of your servants, O <u>blame</u>less one! Grant cleansing of trans<u>gres</u>sions to all!// Receive our prayers and pray to <u>save</u> our souls!

TROPARIA

Resurrection, tone 7

By Thy Cross, Thou didst destroy death! To the thief, Thou didst open paradise! For the myrrhbearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy! And Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, To proclaim that Thou art risen, Granting the world great mercy.

Saint Stephen, tone 4

Your relics have risen from the <u>depths</u> of the earth, like a treasury for the immortal life of all cre<u>a</u>tion. The Church, rejoicing in the grace that she re<u>ceives</u> from them, duteously honors you, Protomartyr <u>Stephen.//</u> Preserve us from error and heresy by your inter<u>ces</u>sion!

Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion, tone 4

The mystery of all e<u>ter</u>nity, unknown even by <u>Ang</u>els, through you, Theotokos, is revealed to <u>those</u> on earth: God incarnate by union without con<u>fu</u>sion. He voluntarily accepted the <u>Cross</u> for us, by which He resurrected the first-cre<u>a</u>ted man,// saving our <u>souls</u> from death.

TROPARIA

Resurrection, tone 7

By Thy Cross, Thou didst destroy death! To the thief, Thou didst open paradise! For the myrrhbearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy! And Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, To proclaim that Thou art risen, Granting the world great mercy.

Saint John of Damascus

Teacher of Orthodoxy, piety, and purity! Enlightener of the universe! And divine inspiration to monastics by your teachings we are all enlightened, and by your spiritual music, O all-wise John of Damascus, pray to Christ our God for the salvation of our souls!

Saint Stephen, tone 4

Your relics have risen from the depths of the earth, like a treasury for the immortal life of all of creation. The Church, rejoicing in the grace that she receives from them, duteously honors you, Protomartyr Stephen. Preserve us from error and heresy by your intercession!

KONTAKIA

Resurrection, tone 7 The dominion of death Can no longer hold men captive For Christ descended shattering and destroying its powers1 Hell is bound, while the prophets rejoice and cry: The Savior has come to those in Faith, Enter, you faithful, into the Resurrection!

Saint Stephen, tone 6

You were the first to be sown on the earth by the Heavenly Husbandman, O all-praised one. You were the first to shed your blood on the earth for Christ, O blessed one. You were the first to receive the crown of victory from Him in heaven, Stephen, first of the suffering God-crowned martyrs.

Steadfast Protectress of Christians

Steadfast protectress of Christians, Constant advocate before the creator: Do not despise the cry of us sinners, But in your goodness come speedily to help us who call on you in faith. Hasten to hear our petition and to intercede for us, O Theotokos, For you always protect those who honor you. **PROKEIMENON, tone 7:** The Lord shall give strength to His people! The Lord shall bless His people with peace!

Vs. Offer to the Lord, O yes sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!

EPISTLE: (124) 1 Corinthians 1:10-18 Brethren, I beseech you by the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. For it has been declared unto me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. Now this I say, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas, " or "I am of Christ." Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? I thank God that I baptized none of you but Crispus and Gaius, lest any should say that I had baptized in my own name. Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas. Besides, I know not whether I baptized any other. For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the Gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the Cross of Christ should be made of no effect... For the message of the Cross is foolishness to them that perish, but unto us who are being saved, it is the power of God.

Alleluia in the seventh tone: It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to Thy Name, O Most High! vs. To declare Thy mercy in the morning and Thy truth by night.

GOSPEL: (58) Matthew 14:14-22 At that time, when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. When it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is already late. Sent the multitudes away, that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food." But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat." And they said to Him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish." He said, "Bring them here to Me." Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes. So they all ate and were filled, and they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments that remained. Now those who had eaten were about five thousand men, besides women and children. Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.

COMMUNION HYMN: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest! Alleluia....

The Transfer of the Relics of the Holy Protomartyr Stephen from Jerusalem to Constantinople took place about the year 428.

After the holy Protomartyr Archdeacon Stephen was stoned by the Jews, they left his holy body unburied to be devoured by the beasts and birds. After a day and a night the renowned Jewish teacher of the Law, Gamaliel sent people to take up the body of the Protomartyr. Gamaliel buried him on his own property, in his own tomb, not far from Jerusalem.

When Lord's secret disciple Nicodemus died, Gamaliel also buried him near the grave of St Stephen. Afterwards Gamaliel himself, who had been baptized with his son Abibas, was buried near the grave of the Protomartyr Stephen and St Nicodemus.

In the year 415 the relics of the saint were uncovered in a miraculous manner and solemnly transferred to Jerusalem by Bishop John and the bishops Eutonius of Sebaste and Eleutherius of Jericho. From that time healings took place from the relics.

Afterwards, during the reign of holy Emperor Theodosius the Younger (408-450), the relics of the holy Protomartyr Stephen were transferred from Jerusalem to Constantinople and placed in the church of the holy deacon Laurence (August 10). When a church dedicated to the Protomartyr Stephen was built, the relics were transferred there on August 2. St Stephen's right hand is preserved in the Serapionov chamber of the Trinity-Sergius Lavra.
