MARCH 25, 2021 The Annunciation of our Most Holy Lady Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary

Great Vespers & the Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom

<u>Lord I Call:</u> Four stikhera from the Triodion, three for the Feast and three for the Archangel

Triodion, tone 5:

Of <u>old</u>, our first parents did not fast according to the Creator's command and received death as a fruit of the Tree of <u>Know</u>ledge.

They were <u>ban</u>ished from the Tree of Life and from the sweetness of Paradise.

<u>There</u>fore, O faithful, let us fast from the food that <u>per</u>ishes and from the passions that de<u>stroy</u> us, so that <u>we</u> may acquire life from the di<u>vine</u> Cross, and re<u>turn</u> with the Good Thief to our ancient <u>fa</u>therland,// receiving great <u>mer</u>cy from <u>Christ</u> our God!

tone 4:

Your side was pierced when You <u>hung</u> upon the wood, pouring life out up<u>on</u> me.

I was <u>dead</u>ened by the guile of the serpent by <u>eating</u> from the tree. Therefore I glorify You, O Christ, and entreat Your compassion:

"Grant me to complete the <u>Fast</u> with compunction,// that I may venerate Your Passion and Resurrection!"

The fruit of the tree brought sorrow to Adam, the <u>first</u>-formed man, for You banished him from <u>Paradise</u>, but when <u>You</u> were crucified as Man up<u>on</u> the Tree You called him back, O <u>Sav</u>ior.

Therefore I cry to <u>You</u>, O Redeemer:
"Set me free from all my <u>sorrow</u>.
cleansing me through tears, repentance, and <u>fasting</u>, now rescue <u>me</u> from my <u>sorrow</u>,//
O most gracious Jesus, the <u>Sav</u>ior of our souls!"

O <u>Lord</u>, in hymns we praise Your life-creating Cross, for by slaying death It has caused life to <u>bloss</u>om in the world. And <u>now</u> we offer It to You in intercession.

<u>Strengthen</u> us as we fast in these <u>holy</u> days; give us strength to battle <u>passions</u> and a<u>chieve</u> a peaceful <u>victory</u>,// according to the greatness of Your <u>mercy</u>, O <u>Lover</u> of man!

Feast, tone 4:

In the sixth month, the Archangel was sent to the pure <u>Virgin</u>; and with his <u>greeting</u> "Rejoice," he an<u>nounced</u> the good news that the Deliverer was to come <u>forth</u> from her.

Therefore, having received the salutation with faith, she conceived You, the <u>pre-eternal God</u>, Who were well-pleased ineffably to be<u>come man// for the salvation of our souls.</u>

The Theotokos heard a tongue that <u>she</u> knew not, for the Archangel addressed to her the words of glad <u>tidings</u>; therefore, accepting the salutation with faith, she conceived You, the pre-eternal God. And so, rejoicing exceedingly, we too cry aloud to You: O God, made flesh from <u>her</u> without change,// grant peace to the world, and great <u>mer</u>cy to our souls!

Behold, our restoration has now been re<u>vealed</u> to us: in a manner beyond understanding, God is united to mankind; at the <u>voice</u> of the Archangel, de<u>lusion</u> is destroyed, for the Virgin re<u>ceives</u> joy; things of the earth have be<u>come heaven</u>; and the world is freed from the <u>ancient curse</u>. Let creation rejoice exceedingly and sing with <u>voices</u> of praise:// "O Lord, our Maker and Deliverer, glory to You!"

Archangel, tone 1:

<u>Ga</u>briel, the greatest of the <u>spi</u>ritual powers, shining with heavenly <u>bright</u>ness, who with the <u>hosts</u> on high gazes upon the light of the <u>Three</u>fold Sun, came to the Virgin and announced to her the good news of the divine and <u>awe</u>some <u>mys</u>tery,// and he inter<u>cedes</u> for our souls.

The great <u>mys</u>tery till then unknown to the <u>angels</u> and hidden from all e<u>ter</u>nity has been con<u>fid</u>ed to you alone, O <u>Ga</u>briel; and you have come to Nazareth and entrusted it to <u>her</u> who a<u>lone</u> is pure.//

Pray with her that our souls be granted peace and great mercy!

<u>Gabriel</u>, ever <u>filled</u> with light, who do the will and fulfill the commands of the <u>Rul</u>er of All, <u>Leader</u> of the angels, most <u>ex</u>cellent, preserve those who <u>hon</u>or <u>you</u> with love,// and pray that our souls be granted peace and great <u>mer</u>cy!

GLORY...NOW & EVER... Theotokion for the feast, tone 6:

The Archangel Gabriel was sent from heaven,

to announce to the Virgin the good news of her conceiving.

And coming to Nazareth, he was filled with wonder at the <u>miracle</u>, and reasoned with<u>in</u> himself:

"How is it that He Who dwells on high,

Whom none can comprehend, is to be born of a Virgin?

How is He, Whose throne is Heaven and Whose <u>foot</u>stool is the earth, to be contained in the womb of a woman?

He upon Whom the six-winged Seraphim and the many-eyed Cherubim are not able to gaze

is well-pleased to be made flesh from her at a <u>single</u> word.

It is the Word of God Who is to come.

Why then do I hesitate, and not say to the Maiden:

'Rejoice, O Lady, full of grace, the Lord is with you!

Rejoice, pure Virgin!

Rejoice, Bride without Bridegroom!

Rejoice, Mother of the Life!//

Blessed is the <u>Fruit</u> of your womb!""
