Palm Sunday Service Texts

Verses on Lord I Call

Tone 6

The grace of the Holy <u>Spir</u>it today has as<u>sem</u>bled us.
Taking up Thy <u>Cross</u> we sing:
"Blessed is He that comes in the <u>Name</u> of the Lord!// Hosanna in the <u>high</u>est!"

Today the Word of God the <u>Fa</u>ther, the co-e<u>ter</u>nal Son, Whose throne is heaven and Whose <u>foot</u>stool is earth, humbles Himself and comes from <u>Beth</u>any, riding on a dumb beast, the <u>foal</u> of an ass. The children of the Hebrews hold <u>branch</u>es in their hands. They praise Him <u>cry</u>ing out: "Hosanna in the <u>high</u>est!// Blessed is He that comes, the King of <u>Is</u>rael!"

O new Israel, church of the <u>Gen</u>tiles, assemble today and sing with the Prophet Zecha<u>ri</u>ah: "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of <u>Zi</u>on! Shout for joy, O daughter of Je<u>ru</u>salem! Behold, thy King is <u>coming</u> to thee! He is meek, bearing sal<u>va</u>tion, riding on the <u>colt</u> of an ass." Celebrate with the children, holding <u>palms</u> in thy hands: "Hosanna in the <u>high</u>est!// Blessed is He that comes, the King of <u>Is</u>rael!"

By Thy command, O <u>loving Lord</u>,
Thou didst raise Lazarus Thy <u>friend</u> from death.
His flesh had been given over to cor<u>ruption</u>,
and he was in the power of <u>death</u> four days.
By this, Thou didst foretell Thy holy Resur<u>rec</u>tion for us.

Old Testament Readings (should be read from LXX texts)

Genesis 49:1-2,8-12 (Vespers, 1st reading)

1

And Jacob called his sons and said, "Gather together, that I may tell you what shall befall you in the last days:

"Gather together and hear, you sons of Jacob, And listen to Israel your father.

8

"Judah, you are he whom your brothers shall praise; Your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies; Your father's children shall bow down before you.

9

Judah is a lion's whelp; From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He bows down, he lies down as a lion; And as a lion, who shall rouse him?

10

The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

Binding his donkey to the vine, And his donkey's colt to the choice vine, He washed his garments in wine, And his clothes in the blood of grapes.

His eyes are darker than wine, And his teeth whiter than milk.

Zephaniah 3:14-19 (Vespers, 2nd reading)

14

Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!

15

The Lord has taken away your judgments, He has cast out your enemy. The King of Israel, the Lord, is in your midst; You shall see disaster no more.

In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Do not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak.

17

The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

"I will gather those who sorrow over the appointed assembly, Who are among you, To whom its reproach is a burden.

Behold, at that time I will deal with all who afflict you; I will save the lame, And gather those who were driven out; I will appoint them for praise and fame In every land where they were put to shame.

Zechariah 9:9-15 (Vespers, 3rd reading)

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

10

And he shall destroy the chariots out of Ephraim, and the horse out of Jerusalem, and the bow of war shall be utterly destroyed; and there shall be abundance and peace out of the nations. And he shall rule over the waters from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth.

11

And you, by the blood of your covenant, have sent forth your prisoners out of the pit that has no water.

12

You shall sit in strongholds, you prisoners of the assembly; and for one day of your sojourning I will recompense you double.

13

For I have bent you for Myself like a bow, O Judah, I have filled it with Ephraim; and I will raise up your children, O Zion, against the children of the Greeks, and handle you like the sword of a warrior.

And the Lord shall be over them, and His arrow shall go forth like lightning. And the Lord God Almighty shall sound the trumpet and go forth in the noise of His threatening.

The Lord Almighty shall defend them!

Blessed art Thou, O greatly merciful One! Have mercy on us!"

To<u>day</u> the Savior comes to Je<u>ru</u>salem, fulfilling the <u>Scrip</u>tures.

He is greeted with <u>palms</u> and a <u>car</u>pet of clothes.

All <u>know</u> it is He: the Lord, Whom the <u>Che</u>rubim praise.

Ho<u>san</u>na in the <u>highest!</u>//

Blessed art Thou, O greatly merciful One! Have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

ODE 1

Choir: The springs of the deep...

troparion: Out of the mouths of the spotless babes and infants, You have brought forth perfect praise. Destroy the enemy by Your Cross and Passion! Avenge the fall of old Adam! By the tree raise him up to his first splendor, that he may sing to You a song of victory.

refrain: Glory... now & ever... Amen.

troparion: The holy Church offers her praise to You, O Christ, Who dwell in Zion. Israel rejoices in You, her Creator. The mountains, like the stony hearts of the Gentiles, exult before You, singing to You a song of victory.

ODE 4

refrain: Glory to You, O God, glory to You!

troparion: Break forth in mighty gladness, O mountains and all hills! Let the trees of the forest clap their hands for joy! Praise Christ, all you nations! Glorify Him, all you peoples, crying: "Glory, O Lord, to Your power!"

refrain: Glory to You, O God, glory to You!

troparion: The King of glory has come. The Lord of the ages has entered. The hour of His majesty is upon us. His beauty in Zion is beyond compare. Come, O faithful, let us fall down before Him, crying: "Glory, O Lord, to Your power!"

refrain: Glory... now & ever... Amen.

troparion: The Lord comes! He holds the earth in His grasp. He measures the heavens with the span of His hand. He has chosen Zion; in her He is well pleased to dwell, ruling the hearts of all who cry in faith: "Glory, O Lord, to Your power!"

ODE 5

Choir: O herald of good tidings to Zion...

refrain: Glory to You, O God, glory to You!

troparion: God Almighty, enthroned upon the cherubim, has given heed to the lowly. He has come in great glory and power. The whole earth is filled with His praise. Peace be to Israel and salvation to the Gentiles!

refrain: Glory... now & ever... Amen.

troparion: Jerusalem and holy Zion, mountain of our God, lift our eyes round about and see! Your children gather from afar. They worship Him Who reigns in you: Peace be to Israel and salvation to the Gentiles!

ODE 6

Choir: The souls of the righteous sing for joy...

refrain: Glory to You, O God, glory to You!

troparion: O Israel, receive God's Kingdom! Behold, a great light is rising on those who dwell in the shadow of death. Let the peoples be renewed through sprinkling with blood divine!

refrain: Glory... now & ever... Amen.

troparion: Release your ransomed prisoners, O Zion! Lead them up from the waterless pit of ignorance! Let the peoples be renewed through sprinkling with blood divine!

Choir – *Kontakion*: Sitting on Your throne in Heaven...

Reader – *Oikos:* You have bound hell, slain death, and raised the world. Therefore the children carry palms and praise You as victor, O Christ! Today, O Immortal Lord, they cry to You: "Hosanna to David's Son! No longer shall little children be slain for Mary's Child. You are crucified for us all, both young and old. Your side is pierced with a spear, defeating the sword drawn against us. We cry aloud in great exultation:

choir: Blessed is He who comes to recall Adam!

ODE 7

Choir: You have saved the children of Abraham...

refrain: Glory to You O God, glory to You!

troparion: the people knelt before You with palms in their hands. They rejoiced with the disciples, crying: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed are You, O most praised Lord, the God of our Fathers!"

refrain: Glory to You O God, glory to You!

troparion: The innocent children sang a hymn worthy of You, O King of Israel and King of Angels: "Blessed are You, O Most praised Lord, the God of our Fathers."

refrain: Glory... now & ever... Amen.

troparion: Bearing palms and branches, the crowd hailed You, O Son of David, crying out: "Blessed is the King of the new age to come! Blessed are you, O most praised Lord, the God of our Fathers!"

ODE 8

Choir: Rejoice, O Jerusalem!...

refrain: Glory to You O God, glory to You!

troparion: Christ your King is here, O Zion. He has come to destroy the senselessness of idolatry, and to restrain the untamed willfulness of the Gentiles, teaching them to sing: "Bless the Lord, all you works of the Lord!"

refrain: Glory to You, O God, glory to You!

troparion: Rejoice greatly, O Zion! Your Messiah, your God, will reign forever. He is meek; He brings salvation, as it is written. Our righteous Deliverer comes riding on a colt, destroying the proud arrogance of those who will not cry: "Bless the Lord, all you works of the Lord!"

refrain: Let us bless the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, the Lord, now & ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

troparion: The band of lawless extortioners was driven out of the temple. They had made God's house of prayer into a den of thieves. They rejected the Redeemer, to whom we cry aloud: "Bless the Lord, all you works of the Lord!"

choir – *refrain*: We praise, bless, and worship the Lord, singing and exalting Him throughout all ages.

ODE 9

Choir: God is the Lord and has revealed Himself to us...

refrain: Glory to You, O Lord, glory to You!

troparion: Why do you nations rage? Why do you priests and scribes imagine vanities, saying: "Who is this, whom children praise with palms and branches, crying: 'Blessed is He that comes in the name of the Lord!"

refrain: Glory to You, O Lord, glory to You!

troparion: This is our God. There is none other like Him. He established every righteous way, bestowing it upon His beloved Israel. After this, He appeared on earth and walked with men. Blessed Is He that comes in the name of the Lord!

refrain: Glory to You, O God, glory to You!

troparion: You rebels! Why have you placed stumbling blocks before us! Your feet hasten to shed the Master's blood, but He will rise again, saving all those who cry to Him: "Blessed is He that comes in the name of the Lord!"

Choir – Katavasia: God is the Lord and has revealed Himself to us...

To You, O God, is <u>due</u> a song.
