SUNDAY, AUGUST 1, 2021 PROCESSION OF THE HONORABLE WOOD OF THE LIFE-GIVING CROSS OF THE LORD HOLY SEVEN MACCABEAN MARTYRS

The origin of this Feast is explained in the Greek *Horologion* of 1897: "Because of the illnesses which occur during the month of August, it was customary at Constantinople to carry the Precious Wood of the Cross in procession throughout the city for its sanctification, and to deliver it from sickness."

On the eve (July 31), the Cross was removed from the imperial treasury and placed it upon the Holy Table of the Great Church of Hagia Sophia (which is dedicated to Christ, the Wisdom of God). From August 1 until the Dormition of the Most Holy Theotokos, there was a procession throughout the entire the city, and then the Cross was placed where all the people could venerate it.

In the Russian Church this Feast is combined with the remembrance of the Baptism of Rus on August 1, 988. In the "The order of services for the holy, catholic, and apostolic Great Church of the Dormition," which was compiled in 1627 by order of Patriarch Philaret of Moscow and All Rus, there is a similar explanation of the Feast: "On the day of the Procession of the Precious Cross there is a Cross Procession with the Sanctification of Water, for the enlightenment of the people, in all the towns and places."

Knowledge of the day of the actual Baptism of Rus is preserved in the Chronicles of the XVI century: "The Baptism of the Great Prince Vladimir of Kiev and of all Rus took place on August 1."

In the current practice of the Russian Church, the service of the Lesser Sanctification of Water on August 1 takes place either before or after Liturgy. Because of the Blessing of Water, this first Feast of the Savior in August is sometimes called "the Savior of the Water." Along with the Blessing of Water, there may also be a Blessing of Honey (thus it is also called "the Savior of the Honey)," because on this day, the newly-gathered honey is blessed and tasted.

GREAT VESPERS

LORD I CALL: (Four stikhera of the resurrection in tone 5, followed by three stikhera of the Cross, and three stikhera of the Martyrs) Resurrection, tone 5: By Your precious Cross, O Christ, You have put the devil to shame. By Your Resurrection, You have blunted the sting of sin and saved us from the gates of death.//

We glorify You, the <u>only</u> begotten One.

<u>Christ</u> was led as a sheep to the <u>slaughter</u> in order to grant Resurrection to the <u>human</u> race. The <u>princes</u> of hell were <u>fright</u>ened by this, for the <u>gates</u> of sorrow were <u>lifted</u>. Christ the King of glory had <u>entered</u>, <u>saying to those in <u>chains</u>: "Go forth!"// And to those in <u>darkness</u>: "<u>Come</u> to the light!"</u>

<u>Oh</u>, great <u>won</u>der! The Creator of the invisible suffered in the flesh in His <u>love</u> for mankind and <u>rose</u> again im<u>mor</u>tal. <u>Come</u>, O sons of <u>na</u>tions, let us <u>wor</u>ship Him, for de<u>livered</u> from error by His com<u>pas</u>sion,// we have learned to sing of one God in three Persons!

We <u>offer</u> You our evening <u>wor</u>ship, O never <u>setting</u> Light, Who <u>came</u> in these last days to the <u>world</u> in the flesh; Who even de<u>scend</u>ed to hell to dispel its <u>darkness</u>. You have revealed the light of Resurrection to the <u>nations</u>.// Glory to You, O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Giver</u> of light!

Cross, tone 4:

Today the divine assembly of the faithful <u>rejoices</u> For the Cross appears through<u>out</u> the world! It il<u>lumines</u> the heavens with in<u>effabl</u>e light, Brightens the air, adorning the <u>face</u> of the earth. The church of Christ exults with divine <u>singing</u>, Venerating and serving the holy and wondrous Cross which pre<u>serves</u> her from above. As we are strengthened by Its power, let us approach the Master <u>saying</u>:// Grant peace to the world, and en<u>lighten</u> our souls!

Let all creation rejoice and dance! For today the Cross shines from heaven to the <u>ends</u> of the earth! It en<u>lightens</u> those who are <u>born</u> on earth, Bringing them to <u>unity</u>. Today mankind exults with the <u>choirs</u> of <u>angels</u>, For the Cross has destroyed the dividing walls And gathered <u>all</u> into one. Shining brighter than the sun, It en<u>lightens</u> all creation with grace,// Showing salvation plainly to those who honor <u>It</u> in faith!

Shining <u>brighter</u> than the sun, Revealing Itself to the world as the sceptre of <u>Christ</u> the king, It <u>shines</u> to all the <u>ends</u> of the earth. It has brought the human race <u>out</u> of hell. And having despoiled hell and overt<u>hrown</u> the <u>enemy</u>, It vanquishes the arrogance of <u>demons</u>. Now It declares the resurrection of the Savior, and saves <u>all</u> who cry:// Grant peace to the world, and enlighten our souls!

Martyrs, tone 1:

Persecution did not shake the <u>roof</u> of the law, Firmly upheld by seven <u>pillars</u>. For they <u>bravely</u> endured the senseless fury of their <u>tormenter</u>, Giving their <u>bodies</u> to the executioners: These <u>noble</u> young men and <u>brothers</u>,// Guardians of the oracles of <u>Moses</u>.

<u>Raising</u> their minds above <u>visible</u> things, Their bodily <u>limbs</u> cut down, The <u>brave</u> and righteous youths, with their divinely-wise <u>mother</u>, Were strengthened by the great hopes which <u>have been</u> fulfilled,// As they now rest in the bosom of their forefather <u>Abraham</u>!

Most holy <u>Eleazer</u>, The young men and their divinely wise <u>mother</u>, <u>Arming</u> themselves firmly with youthful <u>boldness</u> of soul, Gathering <u>strength</u> from zeal, <u>Steadfastly</u> attacked the adversary for the sake of <u>piety</u>,// To preserve the law of their <u>fathers</u>.

GLORY... for the Cross, tone 8:

In <u>ancient</u> times, Moses pre<u>figured</u> the Cross, Casting down <u>Amalek</u> in defeat; Your Cross is the footstool David the psalmist proclaimed <u>worthy</u> of veneration! We sinners honor It today with unworthy lips, <u>Christ</u> our God. We entreat You, for You were freely <u>nailed</u> upon it:// Lord, with the thief, make us worthy of Your <u>kingdom</u>!

NOW AND EVER... Dogmatic of the Resurrection in tone 5: <u>In</u> the Red <u>Sea</u> of old, a type of the Virgin Bride was pre<u>fig</u>ured. There <u>Mo</u>ses divided the <u>wa</u>ters; here <u>Ga</u>briel assisted in the <u>mir</u>acle. There Israel crossed the sea without <u>getting wet</u>, here the <u>Virgin</u> gave birth to <u>Christ</u> without seed. After <u>Is</u>rael's passage, the sea remained im<u>passable</u>; after Emmanuel's birth, the Virgin remained a <u>Virgin</u>. O ever-ex<u>isting</u> God, Who appeared as Man,// O Lord, have mercy on us!

<u>APOSTIKHA:</u> All Resurrection in tone 5:

We <u>magnify</u> You in <u>songs</u> of praise, O incarnate Christ and <u>Sav</u>ior. By ac<u>cepting</u> the Cross and <u>death</u> for our sake, as the <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of mankind, You overthrew the <u>gates</u> of hell,// and arose on the <u>third</u> day, <u>sav</u>ing our souls.

By being <u>pierced</u> in the side, O <u>Lov</u>er of mankind, You have poured out drops of life and sal<u>va</u>tion for all. By ac<u>cepting</u> death in the flesh, You have granted us immor<u>tal</u>ity. You have <u>freed</u> us by being <u>placed</u> in the tomb, and have resurrected us with Yourself in <u>glory</u>, as God.// Glory to You, O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of mankind!

Your cruci<u>fix</u>ion and descent into hell are awesome, O <u>Lov</u>er of mankind. You have captured it, releasing the ancient <u>pris</u>oners. You have <u>opened Paradise and giv</u>en it to us. <u>Grant us purification of sins,</u> who glorify Your Resurrection on the <u>third day!</u> Make us <u>wor</u>thy of <u>Paradise//</u> and <u>save us, O Lov</u>er of mankind!

For our <u>sake</u>, You accepted <u>death</u> in the flesh, to rise from the dead on the <u>third</u> day. <u>Heal</u> us from our earthly <u>passions</u>, and re<u>store</u> us from our evil trans<u>gres</u>sions;// and <u>save</u> us, O <u>Lov</u>er of mankind!

GLORY... for the Marytrs, tone 8:

The <u>souls</u> of the just are in the <u>hands</u> of God: Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the forefathers be<u>fore</u> the law, And their inheritance, the Maccabees whom <u>now</u> we <u>praise</u>. For these sons of Abraham followed him in the faith with <u>strength</u> of soul, Wrestling even to death for the sake of <u>godliness</u>. Raised in reverence and <u>striving worthily</u>, They reproved the godless <u>Antiochus</u>. For the sake of eternal life they scorned the <u>things</u> of this world, Setting aside for God their <u>lives</u>: soul and body! Holy mother, who brought forth for us these <u>seven</u> sons! With her, Maccabees, and the wise priest <u>Eleazar</u>, As you stand before Christ our <u>God</u> for whom you <u>labored</u>, Entering into the <u>fruits</u> of your reward, Ever pray to Him for <u>mankind</u>.// For according to His will, He answers those who pray to Him in faith!

NOW AND EVER... for the Cross, tone 8:

The <u>voice</u> of Your prophet Moses cried <u>out</u>, O God: Behold Your life as it <u>hangs</u> before Your eyes! So today the Cross is lifted up and the <u>world</u> set free from <u>error</u>. Today Christ's resur<u>rection</u> is renewed! The ends of the earth rejoice with David in songs and <u>cymbals</u>: O God, you have wrought salvation in the <u>midst</u> of the earth: The crucifixion and resurrection by <u>which</u> we are saved!// All-powerful, good Lord, the Lover of mankind, <u>glory</u> to You!

TROPARIA

Resurrection, tone 5

Let <u>us</u>, the faithful, praise and <u>wor</u>ship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the <u>Spirit</u>, <u>born</u> for our salvation from the <u>Virgin</u>; for He <u>willed</u> to be lifted up on the <u>Cross</u> in the flesh, to en<u>dure</u> death, and to <u>raise</u> the dead// by His <u>glo</u>rious Resur<u>rec</u>tion.

Maccabees, tone 1:

We be<u>seech</u> You, O Lover of man<u>kind</u>, to accept in supplication the <u>suf</u>fering which the Saints endured for <u>You</u>, O Lord,// and heal all our in<u>firm</u>ities!

Cross, tone 1:

O <u>Lord</u>, save Your <u>people</u>, and bless Your in<u>her</u>itance! <u>Grant</u> victories to the Orthodox <u>Chris</u>tians over their <u>adversaries</u>; and by <u>vir</u>tue of Your <u>Cross</u>,// preserve Your habi<u>ta</u>tion!
