# SUNDAY, JULY 25, 2021 DORMITION OF THE RIGHTEOUS ANNA

Anna was the daughter of Matthan the priest, from the lineage of Levi, as was Aaron the high priest. Matthan had three daughters: Mary, Sophia and Anna. Mary married, lived in Bethlehem and gave birth to Salome; Sophia married, also lived in Bethlehem, and gave birth to Elizabeth, the mother of St. John the Forerunner; Anna married Joachim in Nazareth, and in old age gave birth to Mary, the Most-holy Theotokos. Joachim and Anna had lived together in marriage for fifty years, and yet had remained barren. They lived devoutly and quietly, and of all their income they spent one third on themselves, distributed one third to the poor and gave the other third to the Temple, and they were well provided for. Once when in their old age they came to Jerusalem to offer a sacrifice to God, the high priest Issachar reprimanded Joachim, saying: "You are not worthy that a gift be accepted from your hands, for you are childless." Others, who had children, pushed Joachim behind them as one unworthy. This greatly grieved these two aged souls and they returned home in great sorrow. Then the two of them fell down before God in prayer, that He work a miracle with them as He once had with Abraham and Sarah, and give them a child as a comfort in their old age. Then God sent His angel, who announced to them the birth of "a daughter most-blessed, by whom all nations on earth will be blessed and through whom the salvation of the world will come." Anna straightway conceived, and in nine months gave birth to the Holy Virgin Mary.

According to Tradition, she died peacefully in Jerusalem at age 79, before the Annunciation to the Most Holy Theotokos.

During the reign of Saint Justinian the Emperor (527-565), a church was built in her honor at Deutera. Emperor Justinian II (685-695; 705-711) restored her church, since Saint Anna had appeared to his pregnant wife. It was at this time that her body and veil were transferred to Constantinople.

# **LORD I CALL:** six stikhera of the resurrection in tone 4, followed by four stikhera for the Saint

#### Resurrection, tone 4:

We glorify Your Resurrection on the third day, O <u>Christ</u> God, by always honoring Your <u>life</u>-creating Cross; by <u>it</u> You have renewed the corrupted nature of mankind, O <u>almighty</u> One. By it You have renewed our entrance to <u>heaven</u>,// for You are good and the Lover of mankind.

You loosed the Tree's verdict of disobedience, O <u>Savior</u>, by being voluntarily nailed to the <u>tree</u> of the Cross. By <u>descending</u> to hell, O <u>almighty</u> God, You broke the <u>bonds</u> of death. Therefore, we adore Your Resurrection from the <u>dead</u>, <u>singing</u> in joy:// "Glory to You, O all <u>powerful</u> Lord!"

You smashed the gates of <u>hell</u>, O Lord, and by Your death You demolished the <u>kingdom</u> of death. You de<u>liv</u>ered the human race from corruption,// granting the world life, incorruption and great <u>mercy</u>.

Come, O <u>people</u>, let us sing of the Savior's Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day! By <u>it</u>, we have been freed from the unbreakable <u>bonds</u> of hell. By it, we have received life and incor<u>rup</u>tion. Save us by Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion!// Life-creating and almighty Savior, <u>glory</u> to You!

Angels and mortals sing of Your Resurrection on the third day, O Savior. By it, the ends of the earth have been <u>illumined</u>. By <u>it</u> we have been delivered from bondage to the <u>enemy</u>. Save us by Your Resur<u>rection!//</u> Life-creating and almighty Savior, <u>Glory</u> to You!

You have shattered the <u>gates</u> of brass and destroyed the chains of death, O <u>Christ</u> God. You have <u>raised</u> the fallen <u>human</u> race.// O Lord, risen from the dead, <u>glory</u> to You!

#### Anna, tone 4:

You faithfully <u>observed</u> the law And worked unceasingly for God the Cre<u>ator</u>. He <u>granted</u> you motherhood, O <u>Anna</u>: Your child brought forth <u>Christ</u> in the flesh. With the Virgin <u>Mother</u> we <u>honor</u> you,// And celebrate today your holy <u>dormition</u>.

O divinely-wise <u>An</u>na, you gave birth to the <u>bear</u>er of Life. You pre<u>sent</u>ed your pure child to a <u>life</u> with God. Together with the <u>heav</u>enly hosts, you rejoice in the <u>rich</u>es from on high. We commemorate your <u>fall</u>ing asleep,// and on this day we honor the Divine <u>Wis</u>dom in faith.

Having divine wisdom, you gave birth to the Door of Heaven,

and you achieved heavenly glory for<u>ev</u>er. We <u>cel</u>ebrate your holy dormition, O <u>An</u>na, and ask you to pray that the turmoil of passions not de<u>stroy</u> us,// and that we be spared from fear and deso<u>la</u>tion.

#### tone 1:

Be<u>hold</u>, a bright festival and a radiant day bringing joy to the world, the holy and praiseworthy falling asleep of Anna of <u>great</u> fame, from <u>whom</u> was born the <u>bear</u>er of Life, the living Ark who con<u>tained</u> the uncon<u>tainable</u> Word, the re<u>lease</u> from despondency, the <u>cause</u> of joy,// who bestows great mercy upon all the <u>faith</u>ful.

# GLORY... for the Saint, tone 8:

The blameless <u>pair</u>, from whose <u>fruit</u>less loins, sprang forth the holy branch, the Theotokos, from whom dawns upon the world the salvation that is <u>Christ</u> our God, the holy couple, Joachim and <u>Anna</u>, have now been translated to the heavenly <u>dwellings</u>, with their own daughter, the <u>most</u> pure <u>Virgin</u>, and they celebrate with the Angels, as they interc<u>ede</u> for the world. We also come together and devoutly sing their praise, <u>say</u>ing: "You who have be<u>come</u> the Fore<u>bear</u>ers of Christ, through the child of God and all-pure <u>Mary</u>,// intercede on be<u>half</u> of our souls!"

# NOW AND EVER... the Dogmatic in tone 4:

The Prophet David was a Father of the Lord through you, O <u>Virgin</u>. He foretold in songs the One Who worked <u>wonders</u> in you: "At Your <u>right hand stood</u> the Queen," Your Mother, the <u>mediatrix</u> of life, since God was freely born of <u>her</u> without a <u>father</u>. He wanted to renew His fallen image, made corrupt in <u>passion</u>, so He took the lost sheep upon His <u>shoulder</u> and brought it to His Father, joining it to the <u>heavenly pow'rs</u>.// Christ who has great and rich mercy has saved the world, O Theotokos.

# <u>APOSTIKHA:</u> all stikhera of the resurrection in tone 4:

You have annulled our an<u>cestral</u> curse. By des<u>cending</u> to hell, You have freed the eternal <u>prisoners</u>, granting incorruption to the <u>human</u> race.// Therefore in songs we glorify Your life-creating and saving Resurrection.

By hanging upon the tree, O only powerful Lord,

You shook all of <u>creation</u>. By being <u>laid</u> in the tomb You have raised those who <u>dwelt</u> in the tombs, granting life and incorruption to the <u>human</u> race.// Therefore in songs we glorify Your rising on the <u>third</u> day.

The lawless <u>people</u>, O Christ, handed You over to Pilate, condemned to be <u>crucified</u>, thus <u>proving</u> themselves ungrateful before their bene<u>factor</u>. But voluntarily You endured <u>burial</u>, rising by Your own <u>power</u> on the <u>third</u> day as God,// granting us life everlasting and great <u>mercy</u>.

With tears the women <u>reached</u> Your tomb, searching for You, but not <u>finding</u> You. They <u>wept</u> with wailing and lamented: "Woe to us! Our Savior, <u>King</u> of all, <u>how</u> were you <u>stolen</u>? What place can hold Your life-bearing <u>body</u>?" An angel re<u>plied</u> to them: "Do not weep but go and proclaim that the <u>Lord is risen</u>,// Granting us joy as the only compassionate One!"

#### GLORY... NOW AND EVER... for the Saint, tone 8:

Come together, all creation,

let us praise the divinely-wise Anna with cymbals and psalms!

Through her womb she gave birth to the divine mountain.

Today she is translated to the spiritual mountain and mansions of <u>Par</u>adise.

Let us cry <u>out</u> to her:

"Blessed is your womb, which bore the one who carried the <u>Light</u> of the <u>world</u> in her womb!

Entreat Him that He may deliver us from all tribulation and assaults of the <u>En</u>emy,// and that He may <u>save</u> our souls!
