### SUNDAY, DECEMBER 11, 2022 26th Sunday after Pentecost (12th of Luke) Sunday of the Forefathers

The Sunday that falls between December 11-17 is known as the Sunday of the Holy Forefathers. These are the ancestors of Christ according to the flesh, who lived before the Law and under the Law, especially the Patriarch Abraham, to whom God said, "In thy seed shall all of the nations of the earth be blessed" (Gen. 12:3, 22:18).

# **GREAT VESPERS**

**LORD I CALL:** 6 stichera of the Resurrection in tone 1 (spiral bound Vespers book), then ...

#### Forefathers, tone 8:

To<u>day</u>, as we celebrate the Forefathers' <u>memory</u>, let us the faithful praise Christ the Re<u>deemer</u>, Who magnified them in <u>all</u> the <u>nations</u>! He is the Lord Who does <u>won</u>drous deeds, for He is powerful and <u>mighty</u>! Through them He has <u>shown</u> us the <u>rod</u> of His strength: she is Mary, the only pure and Virgin <u>Maid</u>en of God. From her Christ <u>blos</u>somed,// bringing forth life, eternal salvation, and unending <u>bliss</u>

for all.

O <u>Mas</u>ter, You delivered the Holy <u>Youths</u> from the fire, and Daniel from the mouths of <u>li</u>ons;

You blessed Abraham, Isaac, Your <u>ser</u>vant, and <u>Ja</u>cob, his son;

You consented to become like us by being <u>born</u> of their seed,

to be crucified and <u>bur</u>ied,

in order to save our <u>Fore</u>fathers, who <u>fell</u> of old.

Thus You crushed the <u>bonds</u> of death

and raised with Yourself all the dead of <u>ages past</u>,//

who worship You, O Christ, King of the ages.

<u>Walking amidst the flames as in a gentle shower of rain,</u> the godly Youths exulted in the dew of the <u>Spir</u>it.

By this they mystically prefigured the Trinity and <u>Christ's</u> incar<u>na</u>tion.

Wise through faith, they quenched the <u>pow</u>er of fire. So also the righteous Daniel stopped the mouths of <u>li</u>ons. Through their intercessions we beseech You, O <u>Sav</u>ior

by which we are il<u>lum</u>ined but <u>not</u> consumed.

So also the righteous Daniel, glorious among the <u>Pro-</u> <u>ph</u>ets,

- clearly revealed Your divine Second <u>Com</u>ing when he cried out:
- "I saw thrones set up, and the <u>Judge</u> was <u>seat</u>ed,

and the river of fire flowed be<u>fore</u> Him."// By their intercessions save us from this fire, O Christ our <u>Mas</u>ter!

Let us ask forgiveness of <u>Christ</u> our God,// Who is <u>glorified</u> in His saints!
