Glory to Your Kingdom!//
Glory to Your dispensation, O Lover of mankind!"

# St. Mary of Egypt, tone 8

The image of <u>God</u> was <u>truly</u> preserved in you, O <u>Mother</u>, for you took <u>up</u> the <u>Cross</u> and <u>fol</u>lowed Christ.

By so <u>doing</u>, you <u>taught</u> us to disregard the flesh for it <u>passes</u> away; but to care in<u>stead</u> for the <u>soul</u>, for it is im<u>mor</u>tal.//
Therefore your <u>spir</u>it, O <u>holy</u> Mother Mary, rejoices with the <u>angels</u>.
