## SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2023 AFTERFEAST OF THE ELEVATION OF THE CROSS Martyr Sophia and her three daughters: Faith, Hope and Love

## September 17 The Holy Martyrs Vera, Nada and Lubov (Faith, Hope and Love), and their mother Sophia.

They lived and suffered in Rome in the time of the Emperor Hadrian. The wise Sophia (as her name - Sophia - wisdom, indicates) was left a widow and, as a Christian, steeped herself and her daughters in the Christian faith. At the time that Hadrian's persecuting hand stretched out over the virtuous house of Sophia, Vera was twelve, Nada ten and Lubov nine. The four of them were brought before the Emperor, with their arms entwined 'like a woven wreath', humbly but firmly confessing their faith in Christ the Lord and refusing to offer sacrifice to the goddess Artemis. At the moment of their passion, the mother urged her valiant daughters to endure to the end: 'Your heavenly Lover, Jesus Christ, is eternal health, inexpressible beauty and life eternal. When your bodies are slain by torture, He will clothe you in incorruption and the wounds on your bodies will shine in heaven like the stars.' The torturers inflicted harsh torture on Vera, Nada and Lubov one by one. They beat them, stabbed them and threw them into fire and boiling pitch, and finally beheaded them one after the other. Sophia took the dead bodies of her daughters out of the town and buried them, and stayed by their grave in prayer for three days and nights, then gave her soul to God, hastening to the heavenly company where the blessed souls of her daughters awaited her.

## **GREAT VESPERS**

<u>LORD I CALL</u>: Four stikhera of the Resurrection in tone 6 (spiral bound Vespers book), followed by three for the Feast and three for the Martyrs *Feast, tone 1:* The <u>Cross</u> is e<u>xalt</u>ed; the demons are <u>driv</u>en away. The <u>thief</u> opens the gates of <u>Par</u>adise; death is slain and openly despised, as <u>Christ</u> is <u>mag</u>nified. <u>There</u>fore, rejoice, all those <u>born</u> on earth,// for the curse has been <u>lift</u>ed.

<u>Come</u>, all who <u>love</u> God, beholding the exaltation of the <u>precious</u> Cross, let us <u>magnify</u> it together, giving glory to the one Deliverer and <u>God</u> as we <u>cry</u> aloud: "As You were <u>cru</u>cified on the <u>wood</u> of the Cross,// do not turn from us who <u>pray</u> to You!"

In days of <u>old</u>, Moses changed bitterness into <u>sweetness</u>. He delivered Israel, prophetically inscribing the <u>image</u> of the Cross. As <u>we</u>, the faithful, ever make the sign of the Cross <u>mys</u>tically in our hearts,// we are <u>saved</u> by its might.

## Martyrs, tone 4:

The virgin maidens, bound to one another by the law of <u>na</u>ture, manifestly made stronger by love of the Cre<u>a</u>tor, <u>loosed</u> the bonds of de<u>cep</u>tion with faith! They manfully trampled the <u>En</u>emy and were radiantly adorned with fair <u>crowns</u> of <u>vic</u>tory.// Now they rejoice, dwelling in the heavenly bridal <u>cham</u>ber.

The all-praised Faith and <u>glo</u>rious Love together with divinely <u>wise</u> Hope, re<u>vealed</u> themselves to be namesakes of the most splendid <u>vir</u>tues! As athletes, they overthrew the <u>e</u>vil one who had de<u>ceived</u> our First <u>Mother with guile</u>. Now they are deified and dwell in <u>Par</u>adise// where they fervently <u>pray</u> for us all. Faith, Hope and Love, the daughters of So<u>phi</u>a, sought with faith the beauty of the <u>Bride</u>groom. They <u>united</u> themselves to Him, adorning themselves with divine wounds:

they despised the fire, manifold tortures and a <u>shame</u>ful death.// Through their prayers, O Lord, free us from <u>evils</u>!

## GLORY... feast, tone 1:

The <u>Tree</u> of true life was planted in the <u>place</u> of the skull, and upon it, eternal King, You have worked salvation in the <u>midst</u> of the earth.
Exalted today, it sanctifies the <u>ends</u> of the world.
Angels in <u>heav</u>en <u>great</u>ly rejoice, and <u>men</u> upon <u>earth</u> make glad, crying aloud with David and <u>say</u>ing:
"Exalt the Lord our God and worship at His <u>foot</u>stool,// for He is holy and grants the world great mercy!"

O Lord, save Your people, And bless Your heritance. Grant victories to the Orthodox Christians Over their adversaries; And by virtue of Your Cross, Preserve Your habitation.
