#### SUNDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2023 HOLY EQUAL-TO-THE-APOSTLES BISHOP ABERCIUS THE HOLY SEVEN YOUTHS OF EPHESUS

#### October 22 St Abercius, Equal to the Apostles.

In the time of the Emperor Antoninus (138-161), St Abercius was bishop in the city of Hierapolis in Phrygia. The great majority of the town's inhabitants were pagans, and St Abercius governed his little flock with a heart greatly saddened by the great number of pagans and idolaters, and with fervent prayer to God that He would bring them to the true Light. At the time of a rowdy idolatrous festival, Abercius became inflamed with godly zeal and went into the temple, smashing all the idols. When the furious pagans tried to kill him, three young madmen fell down before the man of God, foaming at the mouth and bellowing. The man of God drove the demons out of them, and they were healed and became calm. Seeing this, the fury of the pagans turned to marveling at Christ's wonderworker, and five hundred of them were immediately baptized. Little by little, everyone in the city of Hierapolis came to believe in Christ and was baptised. The proconsul of the region, Publius, had a blind mother whose sight Abercius restored by prayer, and both Publius and his mother came to faith in Christ, along with many other people. In old age, Abercius was summoned to Rome, where he healed the Emperor's mad daughter. The Lord Christ appeared to His faithful follower several times. People from far and near came to him for help in chronic sickness, and the demons not only feared him but were obedient to his commands. At the order of the Lord Himself, he preached the Gospel throughout Syria and Mesopotamia, and went to his beloved Lord in great old age, in the city of Hierapolis at the end of the second century.

## St. Abercius, tone 2:

With the splendors of divine <u>teachings</u> you destroyed the night of polytheism, O Father A<u>ber</u>cius. You re<u>vealed</u> the dawn in all-glorious <u>mir</u>acles, making those who were in darkness <u>child</u>ren of the day. Therefore, we all celebrate your holy <u>mem</u>ory with faith,// singing hymns to you, O divinely in<u>spired</u> one.

You performed a miracle, O Father,

mingling wine and oil in a single vessel, pre<u>serv</u>ing them in that way,

but when <u>need</u>ed you caused them to separate by di<u>vine</u> grace. By your supplication you caused a gift of warm water to <u>gush</u> forth healing the infirmities of those who ap<u>proach</u> you with faith// and call you blessed, O Father A<u>ber</u>cius.

Dedicating your whole self to God, O A<u>ber</u>cius, you fulfilled the <u>teach</u>ings of God. You received <u>grace</u> from on high, O <u>ven</u>erable one, driving away mankind's many in<u>fir</u>mities. You destroyed the temples of the <u>i</u>dols,// <u>plant</u>ing the knowledge of God in those who languished in wretched ignorance, O blessed one.

### The Holy Youths, tone 4:

The blessed Youths spurned the <u>e</u>vil commands: submitting to God, they were bound, breaking the bonds of <u>false</u>hood. Rejecting worldly rank, they have received the glory of

perfection,//

which won for them the joy of the heavenly Kingdom.

You trained yourselves mightily for the struggles of <u>suf</u>fering, O Saints.

You hid in a cave, en<u>treating</u> the Lord.

With un<u>ceasing supplications you sought power and might</u> from Him

through His wisdom and judgments as the <u>Lov</u>er of mankind.// In a godly manner He commanded all of you to fall a<u>sleep</u> in peace.

Come, O people, let us earnestly hymn the witnesses of <u>pi</u>ety: the divinely assembled regiment,

the blessed choir, the invincible company of martyrs,

the beautiful triumph of the Church of God,

the indivisible assembly,//

the unvanquished army and unshakable foundation of <u>pi</u>ety!
